UK Returns Policy

- **1.** All returns of Products can only be made, and will only be accepted by Tech Store if they comply with the following:
 - a. prior authorisation must be obtained from Tech Store (Digit Computers Ltd) via Tech Store's after-sales management tool or such other method as Tech Store may advise. Such prior authorisation shall be given at Tech Store's sole discretion;
- b. the request for the return must comply with the rules specified in Tech Store's after-sales management tool;
 - c. the Products in issue must be returned within 14 days of the authorisation to return under Clause 1(a);
 - d. the Products must be properly and securely packed with the relevant returns reference and document attached and either be delivered to the address on the authorisation under Clause 1(a) on DDP Incoterms 2010 or be made available for collection by Tech Store's carrier, as determined by Tech Store (Digit Computers Ltd);
 - e. for non-faulty Products, the Products must be in their original condition, unopened and with original seals intact.
 - f. for faulty Products, the Products must breach the warranty in Clause 11.2 of the Tech Store (Digit Computers Ltd) Terms and Conditions.
- 2. Tech Store (Digit Computers Ltd) reserves the right to reject any Products that do not comply with the conditions set out in Clause 1. If Tech Store (Digit Computers Ltd) agrees to accept any non-faulty Products returned that are not in their original condition, Tech Store (Digit Computers Ltd) reserves the right to charge the cost to the Buyer of bringing the non-faulty Products into a saleable condition.
- **3.** Tech Store (Digit Computers Ltd) reserves the right to test all Products returned as faulty and to return to the Buyer (at the Buyer's expense) any Products found not to be faulty. Tech Store (Digit Computers Ltd) also reserves the right to levy an additional reasonable charge to cover the cost of such testing.
- **4.** Tech Store (Digit Computers Ltd) reserves the right to levy an administration charge in respect of the rotation of Products and returns.
